

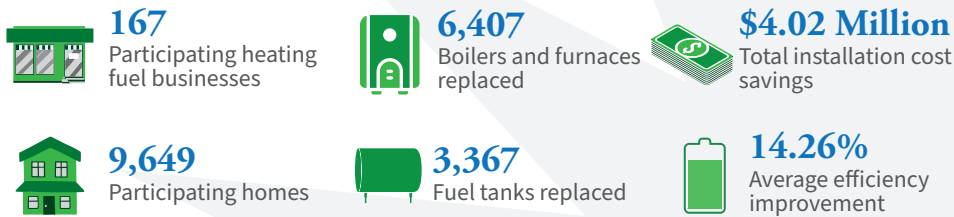

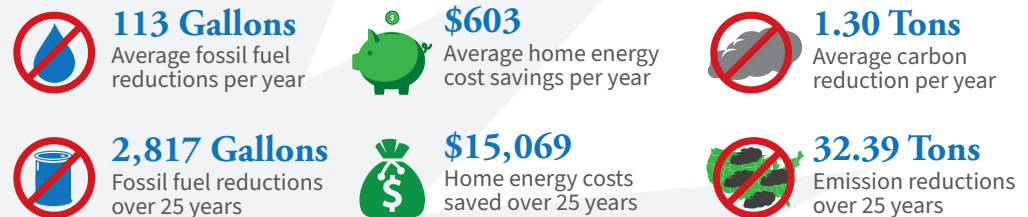

## PROGRAM OVERVIEW TOTAL SINCE INCEPTION (2015)



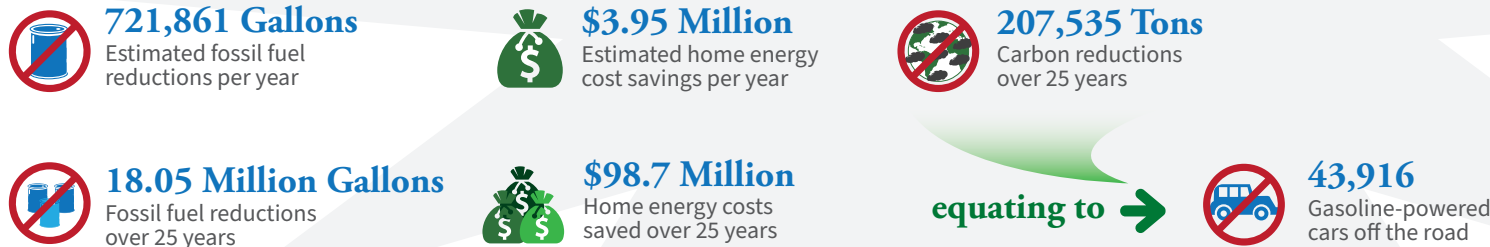
## SAVINGS PER HOME SINCE INCEPTION (2015)

As of July 1, 2025, all heating oil sold in New York State contains 10% renewable biodiesel, and some suppliers deliver blends as high as B50.
